Swim Lessons

Ages: All Campers Cost: \$170 for 5 lessons

All campers may register for optional swim lessons. Instruction is given by our aquatics staff. Instructors are certified as Red Cross Lifesaver and Water Safety Instructor. Parents may purchase 5 swim lessons for \$170. After you submit your Swimming Lessons Form, you will receive a link to sign up for the days you wish your child to have their lesson. Your child must be enrolled in camp on the day of their lesson. Please provide sunscreen for your child's safety. Unused lessons cannot be returned for refund or credit. Full payment is due upon enrollment. *Please note that your child will be participating in an activity which may add increased risk.
